



AC POWER


You can power your portable system by plugging the detachable AC power cord into the AC inlet at the back of the unit and into a wall AC power outlet. BATTERY POWER

Insert 6 \times "C" size batteries into the battery compartment. Be sure that the batteries are inserted correctly to avoid damage to the appliance. Notes: - Use batteries of the same type. Never use different types of batteries together. - To use the appliance with batteries, disconnect the AC power cord from it.



PROGRAM

Up to 20 tracks can be programmed for CD play in any order.

Be sure to press the "STOP button before programming

- 1. Press the "PROGRAM" button, the display will show "01" and flash.
- 2. Select the desired track by using the "NEXT" or "BACK" button.
- 3. Press the "**PROGRAM**" button again to confirm desired tracks into the program memory.
- Press the "PLAY/PAUSE" button to play the CD in the order you have programmed. Program indicator light is illuminated.



3. Control the music from the external audio player.

4. Adjust the volume level on the boombox or external music device separately.

*CD function will be cancelled when connecting the Aux In cable.

HEADPHONE SOCKET

- Connect a 3.5mm headphone plug to the 3.5mm "PHONE" socket on the Boombox
- Connecting the headphones will deactivate the speakers.
