User Guide

Important Safety Instructions

1. **WARNING** : Please refer the information on exterior bottom enclosure for electrical and safety information before installing or operating the apparatus.
2. **WARNING** : To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose this apparatus to rain or moisture. The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing and that no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on apparatus.
3. **WARNING**: The battery (battery or batteries or battery pack) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.
4. **WARNING**: The mains plug is used as disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.
5.  Invisible laser radiation when open and interlocks defeated. Avoid exposure to beam of laser.

CLASS 1 LASER PRODUCT LABEL -

This label is attached to the place as illustrated to inform that the apparatus contains a laser component.



1. **READ INSTRUCTIONS** - All the safety and operating instructions should be read before the appliance is operated.
2. **RETAIN INSTRUCTIONS** - The safety and operating instruction should be retained for future reference.
3. **HEED WARNINGS** - All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
4. **FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS** - All operating instructions should be followed.
5. **WATER AND MOISTURE** - The appliance should not be used near water, for example, near a bathtub, washbowl, Kitchen sink, landrytub, swimming pool or in a wet basement
6. **VENTILATION** - The appliance should be situated so that its location or position does not interfere with its proper ventilation. Do not place on bed, sofa, rug or similar surface that may block the ventilation openings, in a built-in installation, such as a bookcase or cabinet that may impede the flow of air through the ventilation openings.

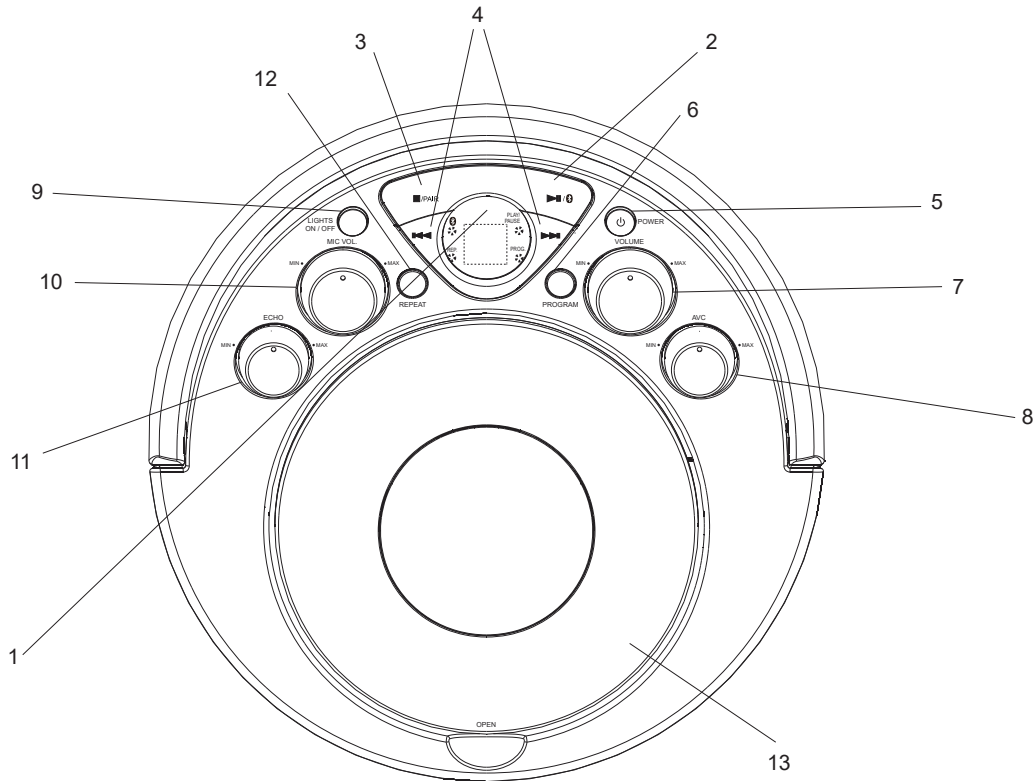

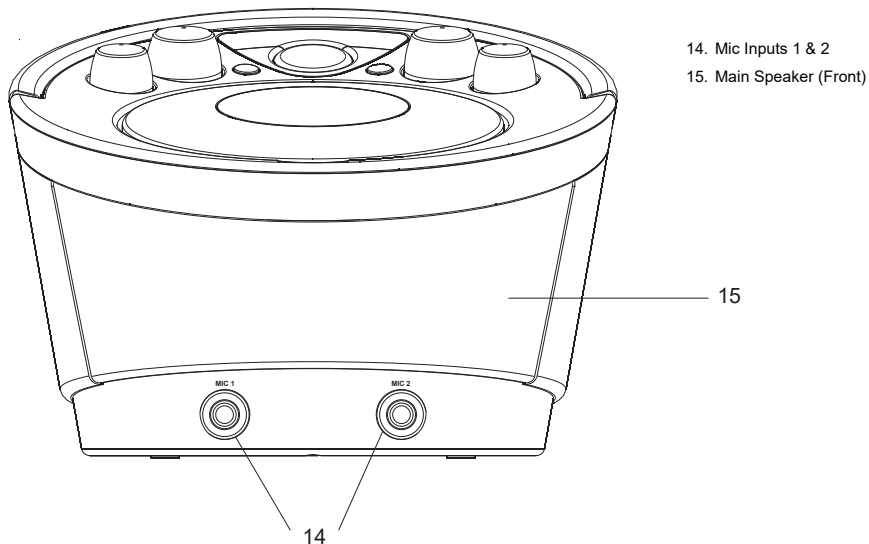

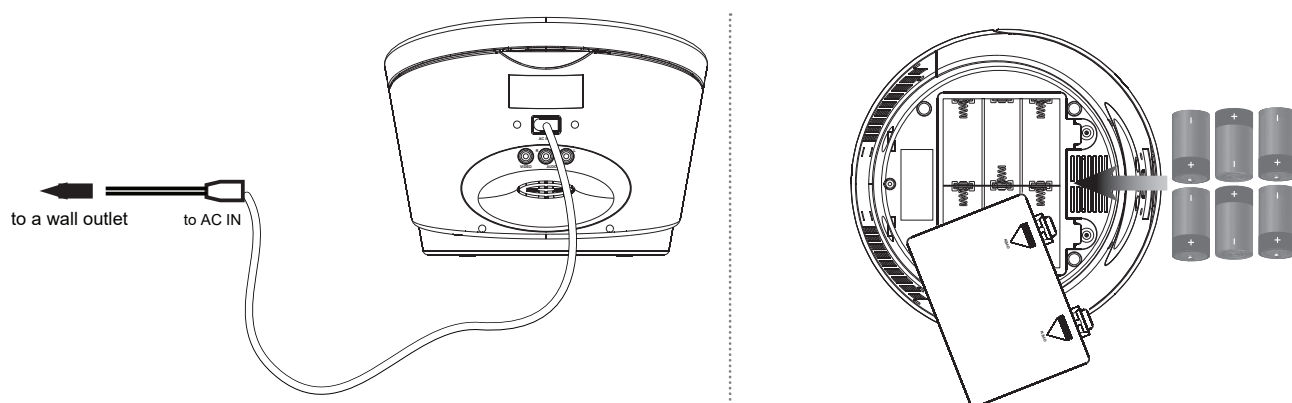

POWER

Power

To power the karaoke machine, plug the AC power cord into the AC Power Input on the rear of the unit and a standard power outlet. For battery power, this unit requires 6 C sized batteries (not included).



CONNECTING DEVICES

Composite Video Output

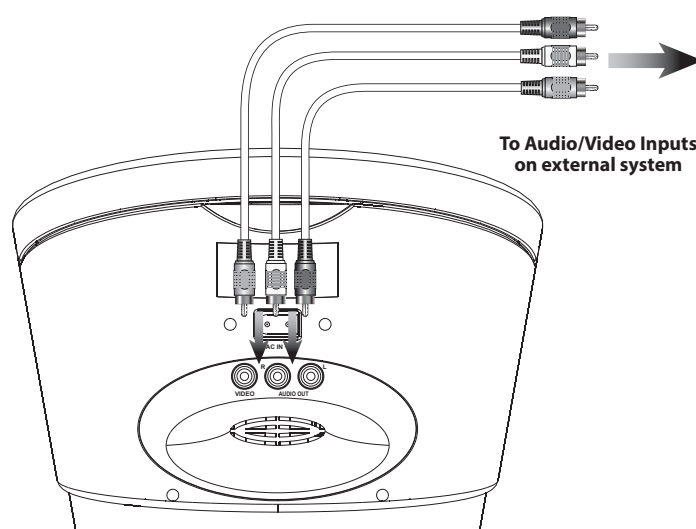
Requires an RCA video cable (included).

1. Connect an **RCA video cable** to the **RCA Video Output** on the karaoke machine and a video input on a television.
2. Adjust the **television source** to the input used in step one.
3. Content played through the karaoke machine will now be seen on the connected television.

RCA Audio Output

Requires an RCA audio cable (included).

1. Connect **RCA audio cables** to the **RCA Audio Output** on the karaoke machine and an audio input on an external stereo system.
2. Adjust the **external stereo system's source** to the input used in step one.
3. Audio played through the karaoke machine will now be heard through the connected stereo system.



CD & CD+G

Loading a Disc

Note: This unit is not compatible with MP3 CDs.

1. Press the **Power** button to power the unit on.
2. Press **Open** on the CD door to open it.
3. Load a CD, CD-R/RW, or CD+G disc into the karaoke machine, label side facing up.
4. Close the CD door.

Playing a Loaded Disc

1. Plug the included microphone into the **Mic 1** or **Mic 2** inputs.
2. Press the **Play/Pause** button to begin playing the loaded disc.

Programming a Loaded Disc

1. Press the **Stop** button to stop the loaded disc.
2. Press the **Program** button.
3. Press the **Skip/Search** buttons to select a track from the loaded disc.
4. Press the **Program** button to add the selected track to the program.
5. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks to play in a specified order.
6. Press the **Stop** button to cancel a program.

Automatic Voice Control

The Auto Vocal (Automatic Voice Control) dial adjusts the volume of the unit to compensate for varying levels of volume from the microphone. Turn the dial to adjust the degree to which the Automatic Voice Control compensates for variations in volume.

To manually adjust voice control use the Echo knob on the front of the unit.

BLUETOOTH

If the unit has never been paired with a Bluetooth device before, you need to follow the pairing instructions below to link the GV-PS923 with your Bluetooth device

Note: if you can't pair the unit with your Bluetooth enabled device, you can try to turn off & on the power of your unit to solve the problem.

1. Turn the power on
2. Press & Hold Play/Pause/Bluetooth Logo Button seconds to Bluetooth model. Bluetooth indicator lit.
3. Press & Hold the Stop/Pair button for 4-5 seconds. Then the Bluetooth Indicator is flashing, the unit will go into pairing/discoverable mode.
4. Turn on the Bluetooth function of your Bluetooth device and enable the search or scan function to find the unit.
5. Select "GV-PS923" from the device list when it appears on your device screen. if required, enter the pass code 0000 to pair (link) the unit with your device.
6. After successfully pairing (linking) the Bluetooth enable device the Bluetooth indicator steadily and a short beep will be heard.
7. Can be controlled by the Bluetooth device or use the Play/Pause, Stop, forward/remind button on unit (*Fast forward/remind will not work with Bluetooth by unit button)
